

Christmas Trees

Activity - Christmas Tree Decorations

Supplies:

cone shaped paper party hats white glue diluted with water 1 inch green tissue squares glitter pom-poms

Method:

Cover exterior of cone with layers of glue and tissue until it is completely covered. Finish with a final layer of glue and sprinkle on glitter. Glue a pom-pom on top.

Suggestions:

Cover table with plastic.
Put name inside cone before starting.
Shake glitter over a tray/tub.
