Activity - Board-type Games

Supplies:

Bingo - traditional

- alphabet

Snakes and Ladders

Memory

Tic-tac-toe

Cards - Go Fish

Power of 10 Cards - Face Off

Method:

Have variety of game choices for each table.

Suggestions:

Invite residents to suggest games to play with the children.

Have extra games as some tables will finish before others.

Children not ready to play can observe. Everyone can do action songs sitting in their chair using upper bodies.
