

Gingerbread Houses

Activity - Decorate Gingerbread Houses and Cookies Supplies: Pre-made gingerbread houses Royal icing Assorted candy Gingerbread cookies Cotton balls Method: Use candy and icing to decorate premade gingerbread houses. Decorate base with cotton "snow." Use extra to decorate cookies for snack.

Suggestions:

"Glue" houses at least 1 day in advance. Explain the candy is an "art supply" and is for decorating houses not eating. Use extra icing and candy to decorate cookies and have this for snack. Take pictures of houses and make a gingerbread house counting book.
