

Remembrance Day

Activity - Poppy Wreath

Supplies:

manilla tag squared off red and black paint peppers cut in half cross-ways corks

green felt pens or crayons

scissors

Method:

Print with peppers using red paint to replicate poppies. Go around circle to create a wreathe. Use corks and black paint in middle. Draw green leaves with felts/crayons (optional).

Suggestions:

Trace circles (use a glass or yogurt tub) in the middle of the papers to guide printing with peppers.
