

Tabletop Choices

Activity - Choices

Supplies:

Math manipulatives and small blocks - pattern blocks, Unifix and multilink cubes, wood blocks, lego Farm animals and barn Felt mats and fairy/gnome objects Car mat and cars Assorted puzzles and games

Paper, pencils, pencil crayons, crayons, felt pens, scissors, craft items and glue sticks.

Magnetic letters and trays.

Method:

Let participants choose activities.

Suggestions:

Remind children to check with residents and bring them the supplies they need for their activity choices.

Invite a local musician to sing songs.

Intentions: Encourage choice of activities allowing for individual possibilities
