

# Valentine's Day

Activities- Puzzle and Sundaes Supplies:

Large heart shape cut into puzzle pieces equal to the number of participants
Crayons and/or felt pens, tape
Strawberry ice cream

Toppings: strawberry/raspberry sauce, fresh strawberries/raspberries, sweet heart candies, cinnamon heart candies *Method:* 

Make a cooperative puzzle by decorating puzzle pieces with kind words or portrait of friend (put in partners so everyone is included). Put puzzle together, flip over, and tape on back

## Suggestions:

Keep shape (heart) a surprise.

Put an x on the back side of the puzzle piece.

Make a class Valentine's Day card or door decoration for each resident and staff member at facility.

Limit number of candies on sundae.

Celebrate Valentine's Day Predict shape of puzzle Work cooperatively to decorate and assemble puzzle
